You must provide your name, address, date of birth, address to which the ballot is to be mailed and signature (if written request). Please be aware that absentee ballots are not forwarded by the postal service, so you must provide the address where the ballot should be mailed at the time of your request. The absentee request deadline is September 14, 2011 for the Special Primary Election and October 12, 2011 for the Special General Election.
