VOTE BY MAIL:

To vote by mail, contact the Elections Office at 313-4170 to receive an absentee ballot. An absentee ballot may be requested for a specific election or for all elections through the next two regularly scheduled general elections. Only the voter or a designated member of his or her immediate family or legal guardian can request an absentee ballot for the voter. Be sure the Elections Office has your correct mailing address. Absentee ballots cannot be forwarded by the USPS.
