

Show Your ID.

Florida Law requires each voter to present both photo and signature identification at the polls:

- Florida Driver's License
- Florida ID card (issued by DHSMV)
- **U.S.** Passport
- Debit or Credit Card
- Military ID or Student ID .
 - Retirement Center or Neighborhood Association ID
- Public Assistance ID

Expired ID's will not be accepted.

Vote By Mail.

If you will be away during the election or prefer to vote by mail, please call the Elections Office to request an absentee ballot, (386) 313-4170. Absentee ballots are NOT forwarded by the US Postal Service. It is the voter's responsibility to provide an accurate mailing address. Ballots can be mailed worldwide.
