Vote By Mail.

Any registered and qualified voter in Flagler County may vote by mail ballot. You may request a mail ballot in person, by mail, online or by telephone. You must provide your name, address, date of birth, address to which ballot is to be mailed (and signature, if a written request). Mail ballot request deadline is March 9, 2016.

Vote Early.

Early voting for this election begins 10 days prior to Election Day and ends the Saturday before Election Day. Any registered and eligible voter in the county may vote early according to this schedule:
