## VOTE-BY-MAIL INFORMATION

The deadline to request a Vote-By-Mail Ballot is February 26, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. Vote-By-Mail Ballots must be received in the Elections Office no later than 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, March 8, 2022.
