Residents of Flagler Beach who are not registered to vote must register by **Monday, February 7, 2022**, to be eligible to vote in this Municipal Election.

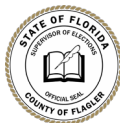
VOTE BY MAIL INFORMATION

Any registered voter in the City of Flagler Beach may choose to vote by mail. The deadline to request a Vote-By-Mail Ballot is February 26, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. Vote-By-Mail Ballots must be received in the Elections Office no later than 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, March 8, 2022. VOTE-BY-MAIL DROP BOX

The Vote-By-Mail drop box is available starting February 22, 2022, during normal business hours 8:30 AM - 4:30 PM Monday thru Friday. On Election Day, March 8, 2022, the drop box is available 7:00 AM - 7:00 PM.

Ballots can be dropped off in the office during regular business hours when the box is not open.
